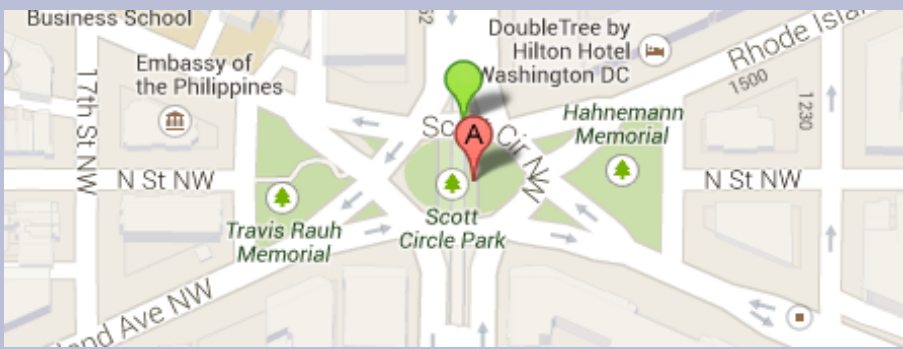

What is your training?

- I was taught – take the case, find a remedy
 - Acute
 - Constitutional
 - But preferably not both at the same time
- Other modalities were discouraged
 - It will confuse the case
 - How will you know what is acting?
 - You will lose the client if you refer
- What were you taught?



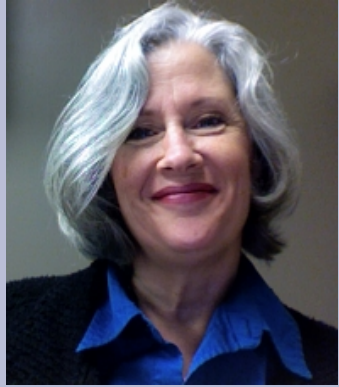
So What's The Problem?

- Homeopathy has its limits
 - Therapeutic process brings stuff up!!
 - Other support sometimes needed
 - The client suffers
- Hahnemann saw more than giving a remedy
 - Aph 150: indispositions
 - Aph 224: friendly exhortations, sensible advice
 - Aph 261: remove obstacles to cure
- How do we implement this?



If the Role of the Practitioner is to 'Heal the Sick...'

- Our job is to help people be well, and homeopathy is one tool – often more is needed
- Mental / Emotional: evaluation / counseling
- Diet / Lifestyle: coaching, nutrition, advising
- Physical support: Tai chi, yoga, cranio-sacral, exercise
- Acute Therapeutics: wise assessment / response
- Adjuncts: Cell salts, Bach Flowers, Herbs, Nutritional Supplements, Gemmotherapy
- Organ Therapeutics: supporting the weak link



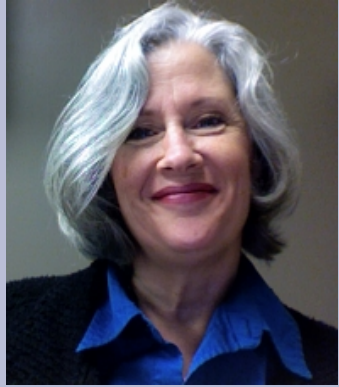
SO... let's change the world together...
